STATE & CDC GUIDELINES

Parents and Caregivers are required to screen themselves and children DAILY and check temperature, prior to coming to the facility. Upon arrival Children's Fever will be checked daily at the school entrance. Anyone with a Temperature of 100.0 or higher or signs of illness, will not be accepted that day.

FACE MASKS

Per State and CDC recommendations, Children over 2 years should wear children's masks (breathable / reusable) or shield visors (available on Amazon). Teachers will assist and monitor their safe and appropriate use when needed. Masks will be sent home daily for wash and return. Please use Ziploc bags.

SICK POLICY

Cold and flu season is upon us and we wanted to remind you about our illness policy. Children need to be fever/vomit/diarrhea free for 24 hours before returning to school. If a child has a fever over 100.0 degrees, they will be sent home and may not return the next day. A sick child must be picked up IMMEDIATELY.

NO OUTSIDE FOOD

All open food items must be discarded before entering the school. Unless, your child has a dietary food restriction then all food items must arrive in sealed containers and will be served by staff in an appropriate, sanitized setting.
